As you can see from the images, Market Street in Dartford is now a public space that's much more about trees, planting, and green spaces than it is about concrete, railings and bollards. They have created new 'pocket parks' to provide calm, natural spaces to enjoy a break or just kick back and relax over coffee or lunch.

The GIFAS PIAZZA in-ground unit has become an integral part of Market Street, being cleverly installed in and around the raised garden providing easy access to single phase and 3-phase electrical sockets for market traders to use, and for future open-air events.

As expected, a Charles Endirect feeder pillar provides the essential link between the main supply cable and the GIFAS in-ground units, and the surrounding streetlights, by housing the necessary electrical protection so that all the equipment can be used.

Phase 1a of the Dartford Town Centre Regeneration is now well underway and Charles Endirect looks forward to further supporting this project by supplying more in-ground units and feeder pillars for use in Dartford High Street.
